

Events: Picked up 3,826 cans from the elementary school for the canned food drive. Helped sort the food for the canned food drive. Drove Santa to the meeting with Santa at the city hall, and helped the city host it. Set up for breakfast with Santa at station 11. We moved apparatus around and helped the city set up and take down all the decorations. We helped with the Santa drive on Christmas Eve.

Training: Senior firefighter Paola read about leading causes of LODD of firefighters and wrote a two-page paper. Firefighter Paola took call numbers from image trend and looked for patterns and differences between the years of 2021 and 2023. Firefighter Paola wrote an AAR on a garage fire that happened in the summer to finish up his fire officer one task book. A-shift completed firefighter personal protective equipment training, ground ladder training, setting up mobile water supply, ropes and knots training, and fire hose training. On the mutual aid fire in echo senior firefighter Paola was able to walk around the structure and provide some training to A-shift. Those trainings included performing a trench cut, building construction training, fire behavior, flow paths, and protecting fire scene evidence.
